What is Advanced Excel?

Advanced Excel is a 5-month program for young ladies (18 and older) with a passion for leadership, a love for discipleship, and a dedication to wholehearted living for God's glory. Each student builds on earlier EXCEL training as they gain real-life experience and develop disciplines and skills vital to fulfilling their God-given role as virtuous women.

Why is Advanced Excel vital?

In a world where excellence stands out, each individual will establish the skills necessary to impact their sphere of influence. The training received is crucial for equipping each young lady to recognize and live out her God-given life purpose.

How is this accomplished?

Advanced Excel involves six weeks of intense training at the Dallas Ministry Center, includes a four-month home practicum period with projects to complete, and concludes with several days of final training and a graduation in Dallas.

What are the prerequisites?

Because of the nature of the course, we ask that students are able to fulfill the following:

- Successful graduation from EXCEL and Passing EIC grade
- Typing speed of at least 30 WPM
- Computer with Microsoft Word and Internet access from home
- The ability to uphold Advanced Excel's standard for excellence and conduct
